Organizations may apply for up to \$3,000. Successful grant applications will be announced on or before October 1, 2010.

WealthSpring supports projects and programs that help women with entrepreneurial training; banking skills; budget and financial management; financial literacy; education and training needed for employment or advancement; and work-related child care needs.
