What is a Builders Club

The Crofton Community Foundation Fund is introducing the “Builders Club” as a convenient way of donating to the continued success of Crofton’s endowment fund. The Builders Club provides the donor an opportunity to show their support by a pledge through a number of donation options, 12 X 12 Club, 25 X 12 Club, 50 X 12 Club to name a few. The pledge can be set-up as an automatic monthly donation directly from your bank, or through other donation options. You can also pledge for one of the club levels and send your donation monthly, quarterly or annually by check if preferred.

The Builder Clubs have been very successful in other community foundations and we hope to continue our success of the Crofton Community Foundation Fund through our own Builders Club.

The Crofton Foundation was established in September of 2010 to initiate a way for the citizens of Crofton and the surrounding area to support the community and way of life we enjoy here in the Crofton area and ensure the community and way of life is available for generations in the future, our children and grandchildren.

When the Crofton Foundation was formed in 2010, we set a goal to have a permanent unrestricted endowment for the future of the Crofton Area. Thanks to all the donors, we have a great start but still a long way to go if we want to achieve a goal for significant annual payout returns to the community. The value of having a permanent unrestricted endowment is that it keeps on growing forever. This is because only a portion of the annual investment the earnings (Payout) are used to make grants back to the community for worthy causes. This will allow continued grow of the endowment plus an annual return to the community. For example a \$1,000,000 endowment would return approximately \$50,000 annually back to the community and those annual reinvestments will increase as our endowment continues to grow. The endowment is a permanent asset to the community and the principle stays in the account, and continues to build for future generations. So as another example a \$1,000,000 endowment that has an annual payout of approximately \$50,000 per year over 20 years would return 1,000,000 over the 20 year period, but also the endowment will continue to increase therefore so would the annual payouts. Just imagine the impact a 1-million dollar endowment would have on the community in next generations.
