



## GIFTS OF GRAIN

The Kearney County Health Services Fund, an affiliated fund of Nebraska Community Foundation, is well equipped to accept gifts of grain to benefit the Kearney County Health Services unrestricted endowment. The endowment acts like a savings account for the future as investment earnings provide a steady stream of revenue to fund projects and programs today, 50 years from now, and forever.

### BENEFITS OF GIVING GIFTS OF GRAIN INCLUDE:

- ✚ The producer can claim all of their production costs as deductible expenses for tax purposes
- ✚ The producer transfers legal ownership to a charity, like Nebraska Community Foundation for the benefit of the KCHS Fund, before it is sold so the producer will not have taxable income from the sale, thus minimizing taxes
- ✚ The producer makes a forever impact in our community by supporting the mission of KCHS to provide exceptional, family-centered care while strengthening the health and well-being of our community

### HOW TO MAKE A GIFT OF AG COMMODITIES

#### THE PRODUCER

- ✚ BEFORE the commodity is delivered, the producer informs Nebraska Community Foundation (NCF) that a gift will be made (Call Les Long: 402.323.7329)
- ✚ Completes a "Letter from the Producer" that includes quantity and type of grain and your intent to support Kearney County Health Services (KCHS) Fund
- ✚ Sends a copy of the letter to:

#### THE ELEVATOR

- ✚ Issues a storage receipt in the name of NCF and sends the receipt to NCF
- ✚ The elevator sends the contract to sell the grain to NCF for signature. YOU do NOT instruct them to sell it
- ✚ The grain elevator issues the check to NCF
