THE PROCESS

Grant applications will be reviewed and considered as received. There are no deadlines for submission and we generally respond within one month of receiving your application. The selection committee will review all applications and may request additional information. Our yearly grant cycle begins July 1st and is open year-round. We cannot guarantee that every grant proposal will be funded, or that you will receive the full amount requested.
