OUR IMPACT

WHISPERING PINES PARK DISC GOLF COURSE

CF's Youth Philanthropy project aims to enlist young people's enthusiasm to build a stronger sense of community and to instill a culture of giving among local youth. The Whispering Pines Park Disc Golf Course was a direct result of that program. BCF offered two \$1,000 grants for youth philanthropy projects. Two sixth-grade students, Owen Rameakers and John Hippen, proposed constructing a disc golf course in the newly established park on the east side of Bennet. BCF decided to award them the full \$2,000. Nebraska Community Foundation matched this with a Youth Engagement Grant. Once the project was initiated, community members volunteered to sponsor holes. With this funding secured,



the developers expanded the original design of a six-hole course to nine holes. Other donations in-kind included labor to construct the forms and install the concrete for the tee pads, labor to help

install the baskets, hole signs, and rock benches and other labor to assist with the course construction. BCF held a ribbon cutting and official opening of the course in June 2021. 🥖

CHRISTMAS IN THE PARK



CF initiated this project in 2020 with the planting of a tree in the Village Park. BCF dedicated the tree to the late Dee Maas, former resident of Bennet and wife of the charter chair of the Fund. In 2020, BCF decorated the park with lights and other seasonal decorations for the festival on the Saturday of Thanksgiving weekend. COVID restrictions limited the activities to a drive-by format. Santa and Mrs.

Claus waved to the occupants of the more than 400 cars that circled the park and delivered treat bags to the children from a chute.

In 2021, the Fund hosted the festival the first Saturday of December. BCF and other volunteers decorated the Park for a full participation festival. Santa and Mrs. Claus arrived on a Bennet Fire truck, visited with children in the gazebo and



handed out 250 treat bags. Students from the Bennet-Palmyra schools played seasonal songs and sang in small groups beside the Christmas tree. Children did crafts in the shelter.

The 2022 Christmas in the Park festival is scheduled for December 3. The goal of BCF is to make it a broader community event. We will ask other community organizations to participate.



CF's activities and projects emphasize the importance of youth in a growing, caring community. In addition to supporting youth through the grants we make (for instance, to the splash pad), the Fund reserves a position on its governing body, the Fund Advisory Committee (FAC), for a youth member. 🥖

ADDRESSING FUTURE CHALLENGES



The Bennet area has changed significantly, even in the past 10 years. As of the recent census, Bennet is now a city. With increased population, the needs of a community evolve. Technology is rapidly changing how we shop, communicate, take care of ourselves, and work. Our vision is to

help the community grow with a high quality of life. We can do that by having the resources available to respond to the future needs and aspirations of our hometown. We will do this by building an unrestricted endowment fund.

An endowment is like a savings account for the community. A portion of the income earned by the endowment is available each year to fund projects to benefit the community as the needs arise. The principal remains untouched, allowing it to grow indefinitely.

Although Nebraska Community Foundation manages the principal for BCF, Bennet volunteers, who are members of our Fund Advisory Committee, decide how to award grants for community projects.
