## THE PROCESS

Grant applications will be reviewed and considered quarterly. The selection committee will review all applications and may request additional information. We cannot guarantee that every grant proposal will be funded, or that you will receive the full amount requested.

## WHAT WE FUND

The Atkinson Community Foundation Fund supports 501(c)(3) public charities (i.e., not private foundations) and governmental entities (this includes cities, villages and school districts) for charitable activities. We encourage grant requests for projects or programs that are consistent with our mission and values and:

- Will have a broad impact on the quality of life for a significant number of people
- Involve partnerships and are funded by multiple stakeholders
- Propose ways to address emerging community issues and needs
- Achieve measurable outcomes/results rather than ongoing operating support
- Support community development and growth
- Encourage others to get involved and knit our community together

Our grant-making approach is rooted in the understanding that community vitality hinges on attracting and retaining people. We recognize that factors such as housing, healthcare, business and employment opportunities, community image, education, and recreation all play pivotal roles in fostering vibrant, family-friendly communities. We favor projects that build on existing resources, foster collaboration among multiple stakeholders, and enhance the community's ability to innovate and grow, rather than solely addressing immediate needs.
